

Make a cat face

Color a paper plate with crayons or markers. Cut out white circles for eyes and glue them on the plate. Glue smaller black circles inside the white ones. Cut out triangle ears and triangle or circle nose. Use yarn or pipe cleaners for whiskers.

Cat Snack

Mix up some cookie dough, roll it out and cut out cat shapes. Decorate them each a little differently. Talk about the sounds that cats make. Ask your child what each cat's name is. Then enjoy! (Shortcut tip: buy the rolls of premade cookie dough.)

Use masking tape to make curves, lines and shapes on the floor. Crawl like a cat and follow the path. Arch your back, meow and purr!

Cat Collage

Cut cat pictures out of calendars, magazines or old books. Glue them onto a piece of cardboard to make a collage. To add to the fun cut the collage into pieces and make your collage into a puzzle. The bigger your pieces, the easier the puzzle!

Sit in a circle or across from your child and roll a ball of yarn back and forth pretending that you are kittens.



Pet Shop



Set up a pet shop with stuffed cats and other animals you have. Stack boxes on their sides to use as cages.
